This is an open records request for all reports, findings, analyses, commentaries, memoranda or directives to and from Dr. Paul Hendrix and his staff pertaining to his obedience to state practices and activity regarding Covid-19 and how the department is working to control its spread.

I demand production of documents pertaining to use of the below-mentioned statute regarding county health officer power imposed on people, businesses, groups or property holders in Hamilton County.

Specifically:

1. Any injunctions pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. **68-2-608**. Orders; injunctions against a business, human being, person or company in Hamilton County

1. Any document, directive, policy, order, guideline or rule under the authority of county power to issue orders pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann.

. Orders; county health officers.

2. Any document, rule, correspondence, directive or other written information created in obedience to

— Tenn. Code Ann. 68-2-609 (1) The quarantine of any place or person, if the county health officer finds that quarantine is necessary to protect the public health from an epidemic;

— Tenn. Code Ann. 68-2-609 (2) The closure of any public establishment, facility or building if the county health officer finds unsanitary conditions of such a nature and extent to significantly threaten the public health; or

— Tenn. Code Ann. 68-2-609 (3) The closure of any public establishment, facility or building, if the county health officer is otherwise authorized by law to take that action.
