Request Three: Contracts for all speakers at the Nov. 4-6 TN judicial conference (including but not limited to the speakers on "general review of evidence," "admissibility and foundation of evidence" and "evidence: relevance and timely objection," "masking CDL/CMV offenses" and "sovereign citizens"
